

Salem Christian County Illinois Jan 27th 1874

To Superintendent Hamilton Dean Septem I just now
venture to write a few lines to let you know that I am as
well as usual & safely at home again I left Portland Oregon
on the 28th day of Nov last on the Steamship Creplam & arrived
in Sanfrancisco but on the 2^d day of Dec & made the trip across
the mountains in eleven days coming at home in Palmer on the 16th
day of Dec having been gone from home a little less than two months
& had no sickness while out I had a hard struggle while in the
City of Portland between going home or going to see you I
did want to go ^{to see you} very much and knowing as I did that it ^{were} late
in the season ^{to} take a trip by sea or to cross the mountains
in the snowy season & more I was very short of funds &
it placed me in every perplexing circumstance I had went out there
to seeugl Journd on purpose to look after a quarter section
of Land which I had bought from one of my neighbors here in
Palmer & thought I should sell for only \$250. when I started
from home & when I got back to Portland I had but \$40. & when
I met your friend Lewis from Lawrence he urged me to go &
see you saying he believed you would supply my deficiency of
money I really did not wish to make myself burden some visiting
my friends & you were kind enough to tell me that I would pay my
way I could not sell my land while there so I implored a man
to sell my land for me I got a letter from him last week &
he says he has not sold it yet so I wrote him immediately
not to sell it as I should go there next Spring & should live
until spring or I care not stand the cold nor heat weather
here any longer your Brother William says he will go out
here with me & do not expect to return to this country again but
May there until I die near Sugal Journd or none I want very
much that you should write me a letter since I have known
