TO OREGON DONATION LAND CLAIM FILES IN THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES

EXPLANATION OF THE OREGON DONATION LAND CLAIMS, FILES AND INDEX:

The Oregon Ponation Land Claims were a donation land grant by the United States Government to settlers of Oregon Territory who arrived in the Territory before December 1, 1853. The land was donated to the individual who had to be a resident of Oregon before December 1, 1853.

These Donation Land Claims contain valuable evidence to all concerned with the origins of the early settlers of Oregon. (For a history of the Claims consult- H. H. Bancroft, "History of Oregon" V-2, Page 260 ff.)

FILES_NATIONAL ARCHIVES

The Oregon Donation Land Claim Files in the National Archives contain evidence as to the right to the claim, including proof of migration to Oregon, birth in the United States or citizenship and marriage status.

For copy of a Claim write the National Archives, Washington, 25 D.C. Send the certificate number which is the File number. Ask for the cost of both microfilm and photostat. Microfilm is less expensive if microfilm reader is available at library, court house or abstract office.

IN DEX:

The Oregon Donation Land Claims Index starts in this the September 1953
Bulletin of the Genealogical Forum of Portland Oregon. It is arranged alphabetically and was compiled by the ORECON STATE ARCHIVES from abstracts of Claims filmed by the National Archives, (File Microcopy 145). The entries have been checked and completed by the staff of the National Archives.

In order to accommodate the settlers in different sections of Oregon Territory, Land Offices were established in centrally located towns, that is:

Land Office, Oreson City, Oreson, specified as OC in Index

Land Office, Roseburg, Oregon, specified as RB in Index / all land will be located in the Willamette Meridian unless otherwise designated.

FOR EXAMPLE the Index shows:

Isaiah Abbet and w OC 3891 320.40 55 lE 1 In other words: Isaiah Abbet and wife, Claimant to land, filed his Certificate No 3891, for 320.40 acres of land located in Township 5 South, Range 1 East, Section 1, Willamette Meridian, at the Land Office at Oregon City, Oregon.
